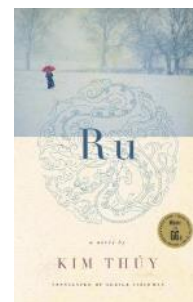


September 28: **Longbourn** by Jo Baker (Sep 28/15)
