Kids aged 5-12 can join us for stories, crafts, games, puppet shows, prizes and lots of great reading...

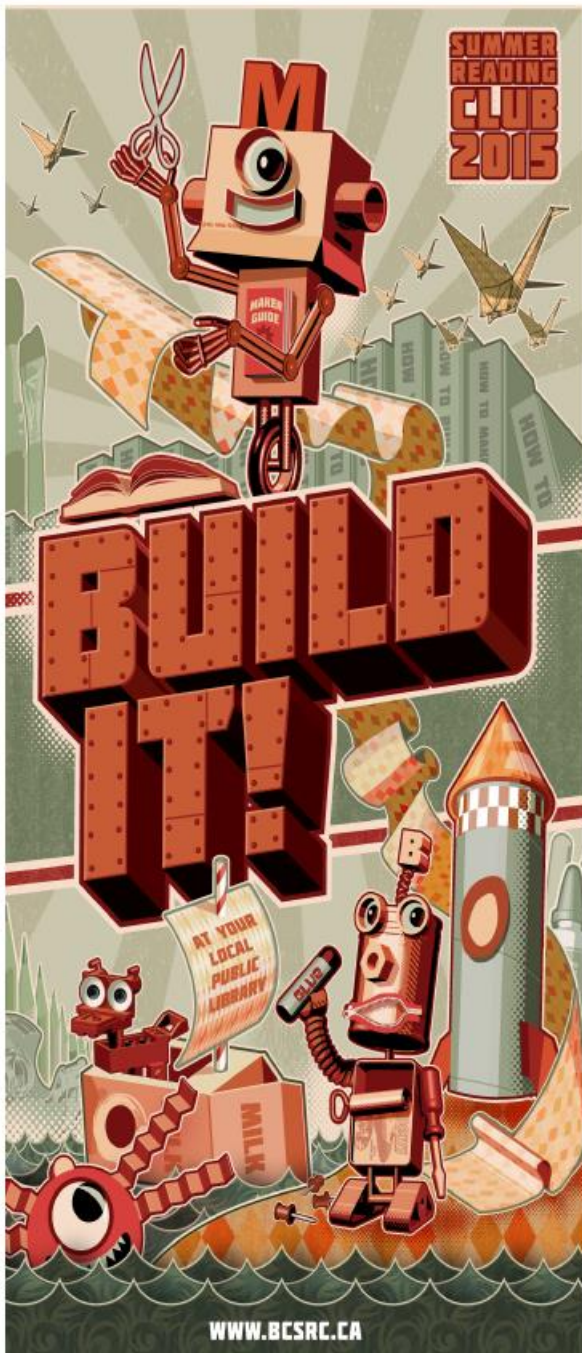
