

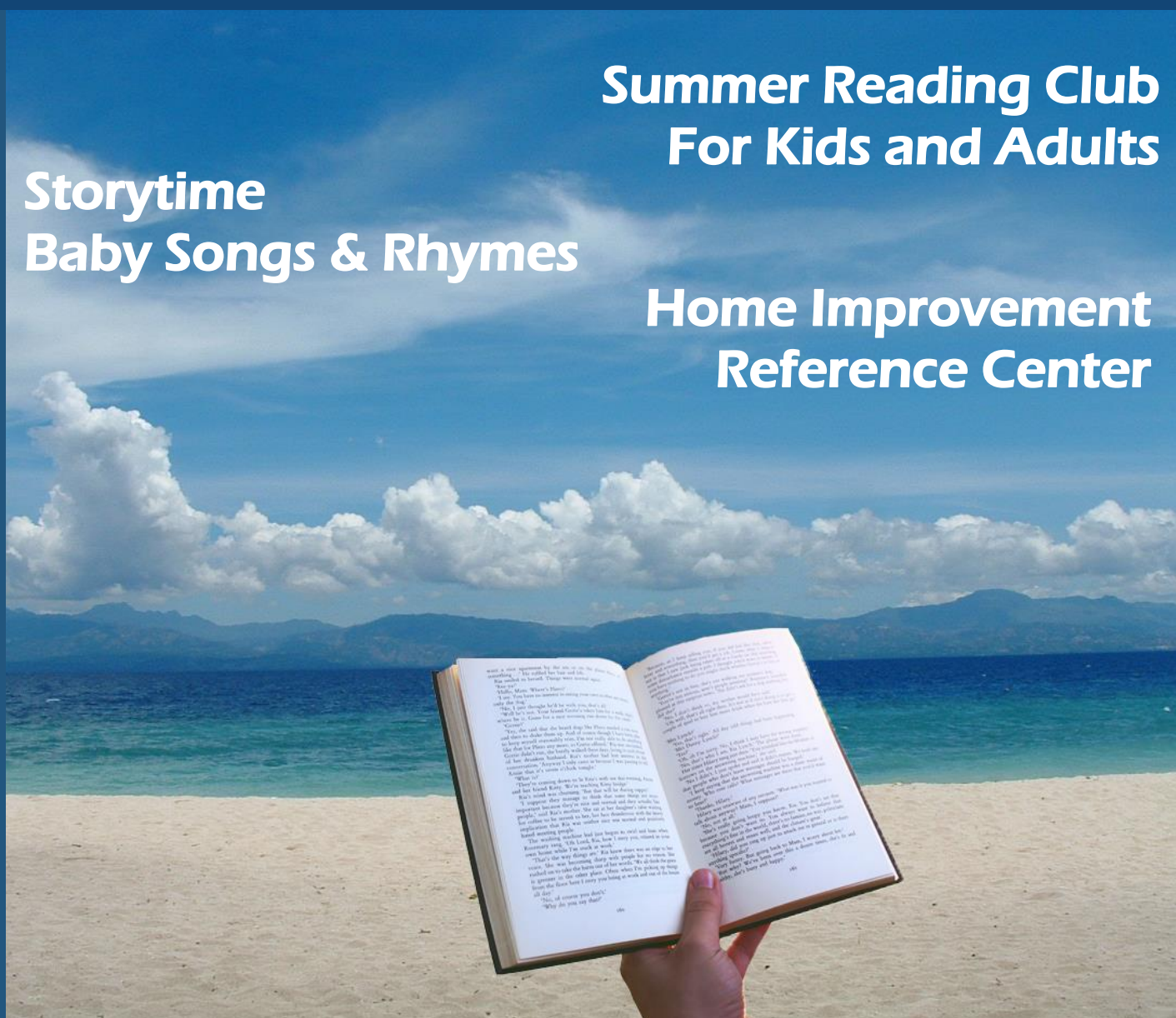

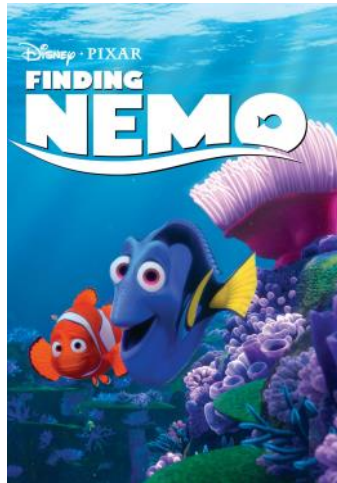

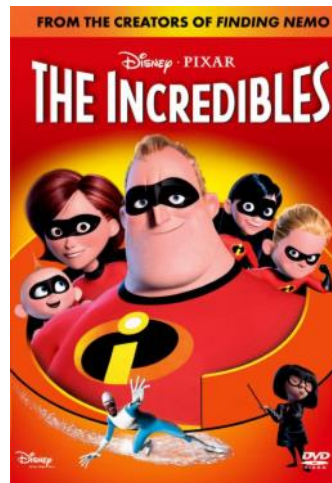

## Penticton Reads

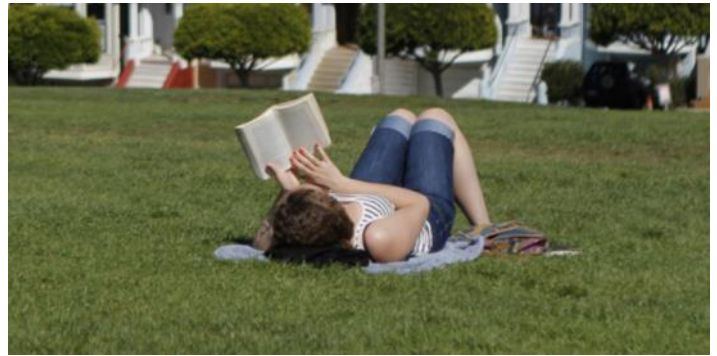
In addition to the popular Kids' Summer Reading Club, the Library is excited to launch Penticton Reads for our adult readers.

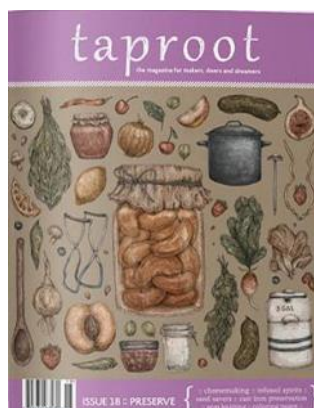

**Taproot** is an ad-free, independent magazine focusing on food, farm, family and craft.



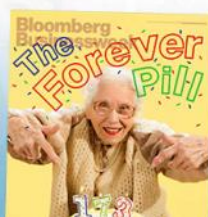
