June 24- **Animal Rights and Welfare** - Laura Fidalgo

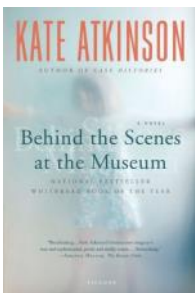
Animals deserve love and care. Laura Fidalgo, from the BC SPCA will talk about: why animal rights matter and how the media can affect animal rights.
